Reminder about Events

When you are putting your events onto the 'What's On' guide please remember to add all the essential information. The most crucial elements are:

- Date and location of event
- What the event actually is
- Contact details for further information

Without these essential pieces of information you could potentially be losing a percentage of your potential audience!

Don't forget, once you have entered items onto the diary you can go back in and alter the information as many times as you like - so don't worry if you miss something off first time!

To amend a entry on the 'What's On' guide

Simply login to your admin area, go to 'View Diary Entries' and click the 'modify' icon next to the entry to make any changes to the entry. Save your changes and the event will automatically be updated - it's as simple as that!
