The primary aim of the group is the protection and conservation of badgers. Run by enthusiastic volunteers we enjoy the support of the Wakefield Council's Countryside Service, the RSPCA, the local Police and we are members of the Badger Trust.



## ABOUT BADGERS

Badgers are amongst the most distinctive and best loved British mammals. Even though they are shy and nocturnal, people are familiar with their black and white striped faces. Many people up and down the country devote their time to conserving these beautiful creatures. Badgers live in social groups in underground homes called setts, they have few natural enemies, apart from man. Fortunately badgers and their setts are legally protected.

## WHAT WE DO

The Wakefield group has much experience in protecting badgers such that local populations are recovering. Enjoyable group activities include; badger watching, conservation walks, fund raising events and talks. We also protect, monitor and build artificial badger setts, encouraging badgers back into the area.

## WHAT A POSER

*The European Badger (meles meles) belongs to the mustelidae family, along with other musk bearing animals such as otters and weasels. Easily recognised by its distinctive black and white striped face but with a shy nocturnal lifestyle not many people have seen it alive in its natural surroundings. By nature, they are clean intelligent animals who live together in social groups, each with its own territory. Badgers have been present in Britain for thousands of years.*

*These projects present the biggest challenge to the group, despite this we have completed many setts.*

*If the site is carefully chosen then badgers will move in, some of our best results include one sett where an adult male badger was seen to emerge just four days after completion and cubs were born in the same sett the following spring!*
